

Cost comparison between columbarium and in-ground burials (2016 costs)

Columbarium:

Cost per unit, with 2 cremation burials, will vary between **\$1,900 and \$2,450**

In-ground burial: (2016 costs)

| 4 corner stones | \$150 |
| 2 cremation burials | \$ 500 |

Memorial monuments vary between **\$1,500** for a **12" x 24"** flat marker to **\$3,000** for a **24" x 24"** vertical monument. (Each suitable for two inscriptions)

Total cost for 2 cremations, based on the above estimated numbers will vary between **\$2,650 and \$4,150**

Larger monuments can easily double the above cost of the 24" x24" monument.

Our normal burying season is April to November. Because the columbarium is all above ground, depending on weather, the option to inter could possibly begin earlier, and extend later in the season.

In-Ground full burials

Lot cost, corner stones, burial costs: **\$1,550.00**
Monuments, (see above)

Based on the above assumptions the costs will vary between **\$3,050 and \$4,550** for a single person burial.
